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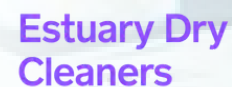

# A MOMENT OF APPRECIATION FOR OUR SPONSORS



**In the heart of Bunbury, just a few streets from the ocean breeze and the hum of Victoria Street, sits a restaurant that has quietly become a cornerstone of the Southwest food scene— Market Eating House.**

When chef Brenton Pyke along with his wife Bec returned to his hometown, he brought with him more than just experience from big-city kitchens. He carried the philosophy that great food should bring people together. After years working in respected venues — including stints at Andaluz Bar & Tapas and Melbourne's The Little Press — Brenton and his wife Bec decided Bunbury was the perfect place to create something of their own.

In 2015, Market Eating House opened its doors and quickly helped spark a dining revival in the coastal city. What they created wasn't just a restaurant — it was a gathering place. Inside, the warmth of open flames from a custom charcoal grill and wood-fired oven fills the kitchen with life, and the menu is designed around food meant to be shared.

Brenton's cooking is bold but comforting, drawing inspiration from Middle Eastern and Levantine flavours. Plates arrive kissed by fire: charred vegetables, grilled seafood, lamb spiced with fragrant herbs, and dishes designed to be passed around the table between friends. It's the kind of food that feels generous – the sort that invites conversation, laughter, and another glass of wine from the nearby Geographe region.

But perhaps what makes Market special isn't just the food. It's the spirit behind it. The restaurant reflects the values of its owners: community, hospitality, and family. Over the years, Market Eating House has supported many local events and charities (just like this one) while building a loyal following of diners who treat the venue as their second dining room.

In 2024 Brenton and Bec opened "The Old Lyric" located on the top floor of Bunbury's historic Lyric Theatre on Victoria Street originally built in 1905. The project was developed by Brenton and Bec to create a dedicated event space. It now hosts Weddings, private dinners, corporate functions, cooking classes and food focused event. Through Market Eating House and The Old Lyric Brenton and Bec have created something that bridges generations. A venue where the history of Bunbury's culture life meets the city's modern dining scene.

For Brenton Pyke, success isn't measured by awards or accolades. It's measured in full tables, shared plates, and the simple moment when someone tastes a dish and smiles.

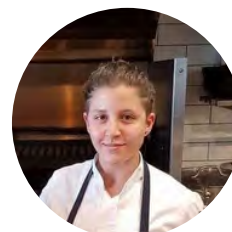

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# 2026 BENEFICIARIES



## **Brunswick Junction Volunteer Fire and Rescue**

Purchase of 4 x iPad Air 11inch with Wifi and Cellular

We will utilise the purchase of iPads for our in-vehicle mobilisation as well as for our team training and activities for our public engagement. Utilising the BART software we will be able to have real time tracking of our vehicles when on call giving our Officers greater oversight and peace of mind when managing our personnel. This will also aid us in our turnout to emergencies state wide. In terms of the training we hope to use these tablets to increase the range and types of training available to our members and to our other support agencies including St John WA, WA Bushfire Service and the SES. We will then also be able to utilise the tablets when conducting Community engagement evens such as school visits, community days and the Brunswick Show. Although the direct benefiet will be to our brigade the benefit that comes from our greater training and response capability will emanate the the greater community of Brunswick Junction and our mutual response areas such as Harvey, Binnigup, Myalup, Australind, Burekup and Collie.

## **Bunbury Rowing Club**

Safety Boat Outboard Motor

The project is to purchase an outboard motor to fit to our safety and coaching boat. This boat is used by our coaching team and accompanies rowers when on the water. The boat and outboard is also used when we hold regattas twice a year on the Leschenault Inlet and the Collie River. We have a strong program of School aged children rowing and also Masters rowers who are aged 55+. These groups along with open rowers will gain maximum benefit from this project as the outboard will be used as a safety and coaching boat which is in daily use throughout the year. Often this boat is on the water twice a day. Once early in the morning and then again after school on weekdays and then again on Saturday morning for our club session.

## **Harbour Refuge and Support Services**

Whitegoods for new refuge

We are opening a new refuge in early to mid 2026 and we will be needing to purchase white goods and electrical goods. The refuge is an expansion of the existing building and will offer crisis accommodation to women and children escaping family and domestic violence. The new refuge will provide support to up to 200 women and children each year. This will bring the total number of women and children in Harbour refuge accommodation to 520 women and children each year. Women and children staying in the refuge will be the direct beneficiaries. They will be able to access all the household amenities as they plan for the next step in their recovery.

# 2026 BENEFICIARIES



## Milligan

Outdoor heaters, chairs and tables for Dinner at Milligan

Milligan currently holds a monthly free community dinner called Dinner @ Milligan but it is far more than just a meal. It's a space for connection, belonging, and community strength—a warm, low-barrier event that welcomes everyone, regardless of circumstance. It's designed to build resilience through storytelling, shared food, and human connection whilst tackling food insecurity. Our community, particularly those experiencing food insecurity or social isolation benefit from this project.

## Pregnancy Assistance Bunbury

Feeding our Babies (Major Grant) - A project designed to ensure all our babies are receiving the nutrition they need.

Pregnancy Assistance Bunbury ("PA") serves new parents and their children in Bunbury and surrounding communities, providing information, emotional support, material goods, and referrals to other support services. An important part of our work is helping parents to feed their babies, with more clients requesting support with feeding than anything else. Our stocks of donated items are not sufficient to meet the needs of vulnerable families who seek our help. We are seeking a CLTL grant to supplement our supply of feeding items, and in doing so support the healthy development of vulnerable children throughout the South West.



PA encourages breastfeeding where possible, but recognises that many families formula feed for various reasons. Whether parents choose to breastfeed or bottlefeed, PA staff provide education, advice and help making contact with support services including child health nurses, the Australian Breastfeeding Association and lactation consultants. Our clients frequently request items such as bottles, sterilisers, bottle warmers, formula and formula dispensers. In addition, breastfeeding mothers require breast pumps (manual or electric), milk storage bags, nipple creams and breast pads.

Many of these items are prohibitively expensive for vulnerable families under financial pressure to provide all that is needed for a new baby during a cost of living crisis. PA's "Feeding our Babies" project would aim to provide clients with a starter kit comprising two new bottles, a microwave steriliser, and a bottle warmer. For parents planning to formula feed, a tin of formula and formula dispenser would also be provided.

To help breastfeeding mothers, we are seeking to purchase three high-quality electric breast pumps to be loaned to our most vulnerable clients (with an appropriate incentive to return them in good working order once they are no longer required). Breastfeeding mums would also be provided with milk storage bags, nipple balm, breast pads, and, where appropriate, manual breast pumps from our donated supply. Providing clients with the abovementioned items would also give PA the opportunity to educate carers about their correct use, for example, the importance of sterilising bottles correctly and serving milk at a safe temperature. Much of the anxiety we see in our clients is related to feeding.

A CLTL grant would allow us to help give babies the best start in life, and ease financial distress for a significant number of families in the South West.

# 2026 BENEFICIARIES



## **South West Opera Company Inc** New Clavinova Piano

The South West Opera Company is a not for profit musical company that performs a variety of music across the South West such as the opening of the BORR, Bunbury Centrepont Christmas Carols, Harvey Harvest Festival, Bunbury Fringe Festival. We also produce our own range of musical events such as - The Phantom of the Opera (BREC), Pirates of Penzance (BREC), Christmas Concert series (St Boniface) and requiem choral performances.

All of these events require the use of a Clavinova piano. Our current piano is far out dated and aging. A new Clavinova will allow us to continue our performances across the South West. It will also be easier to transport than our current piano and therefore allow us to increase our range. Benefiting both Performers and Audiences across the South West. The greatest benefit for this project will be experienced by our 55 singing members. Music and singing is a proven factor in emotional wellbeing. It also promotes social connection and a sense of community. Our group meets to rehearse 2 nights per week. The piano is essential for these rehearsals. The other major beneficiaries for this project are the local community that support us by being a part of the audience at all of our events. Attending concerts allows people to connect with others through music. We often have audience members comment on how much joy, peace and fun they experience.

## **Thommo's Community Garden Inc** Shelving for Nursery and Craft Room

Construct shelving for both our nursery and craft room where we create plants and items for sale at our 2 Open Days each year to raise funds to enable us to grow and donate approximately \$65,000 worth of organically grown vegetables to Foodbank in Bunbury each year.



## **Zonta Club of Bunbury Inc**

Grant will be used to purchase car parts to make vehicles roadworthy, for transfer of vehicles, plus registration if needed.

The project operates at Advanced Auto Solutions in Bunbury by Nathan Reed. Cars are donated and made roadworthy, transferred, licensed if unlicensed and donated to domestic violence victims. Harbour Refuge in Bunbury selects the recipients of the vehicles based on need. This project gives women not just transportation, but independence—a crucial step in rebuilding their lives. Having access to a car allows them to find or maintain employment, take their children to school, and begin a new chapter with greater stability and confidence.

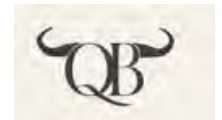

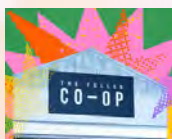

# AUCTION DETAILS

## **Chris Waddingham | Auctioneer**

Chris has been an auctioneer since 1994, having previously worked as a livestock agent and current auctioneer for Waddingham Rural Agencies

Over the past 17 years, his expertise as an auctioneer has helped us raise significant funds.



## **Terms and Conditions**

1. The highest bidder accepted by the Auctioneer will be the buyer, with the Auctioneer having the right to refuse any bid if it is not in the best interest of the seller.
2. A bidder may bid on behalf of another entity. This bidder will take full responsibility for payment of the item if successful.
3. The amount of the advance of each bid is regulated by the Auctioneer and no bidder can retract their bid once accepted by the Auctioneer.
4. If any dispute arises in relation to any bid, the Auctioneer may immediately either determine the dispute or resume the bidding at the stipulated last undisputed bid.
